



National School Improvement Tool training for school leaders

The School Improvement Unit (SIU) offers unique training opportunities for school leaders. The training provides principals and associate leaders with detailed information about:

- school reviews
- how the *National School Improvement Tool* (NSIT) can be used to drive school improvement.

Training for principals

In the two-day training, principals will develop:

- the skills necessary to qualify and nominate as a peer reviewer
- a deep understanding of the nine domains of the NSIT
- an understanding of how the tool can be used to drive school improvement.

Training for associate leaders

In the one-day training, associate leaders (including deputy principals, heads of curriculum, heads of department, heads of special education services, literacy and numeracy support teachers, master teachers, coaches and lead teachers) will develop their understanding of:

- the nine domains of the NSIT
- how the tool can be used to drive school improvement
- a common language to plan, monitor and describe school improvement.
